
Replacing Knife Assembly

ALWAYS READ INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE COMMENCING

Difficulty: Easy

Material Needed: Flat Head Screwdriver, Philips Screwdriver, Protective Gloves

Instructions:



*Don't use force to release those 2 side tabs. You may break them.

You will now see a couple of screws when you remove the lid on the top side of the hood. Unscrew the 2 screws as shown on the picture with a Philips screw driver while holding the knife assembly from the other side. Use protective gloves to hold the knife assembly.



Make sure to remove all broken parts in case of plastic knife seat is broken.

There are 2 springs located on the top of the knife set, be careful to not to drop them.

*Make sure you have safety gloves on when you're holding the knife assembly.



Replace the broken assembly with the new one. You will need to hold the new assembly in place while screwing in the 2 screws.

It may be necessary to put some pressure on the cover to compress the knife springs so that you can engage the screws. Tighten the screw until you feel it gets harder to tight.

*Don't tight it too much, you may damage the plastic knife seat.

*Make sure you have two springs on before putting it in the place.

*Be careful at the knife assembly location and direction of the blade before, as shown on the picture.

Replace the lid and be careful about the tabs.



Plug in your CiMa-Pak Tray Sealer, and you are ready to continue production.
