

System: Classic, Small Classic, Model II

Problem: Machine is not heating up

Possible Reasons: The high temperature switch may have been tripped

Brief Description: If the machine is opened too fast, this can trip the high temperature switch.

Solution:

Steps	Illustrations
Turn your machine on, and check to see if the light on the on/off switch is illuminated	
If the light in on, then turn off the machine, unplug the machine, and unscrew the four (4) screws that are on top of the machine Note: Never work on a piece of equipment that is still plugged into a power source.	
Take the cover off to reveal a smaller cover, then unscrew the two (2) back screws and the one (1) side screw

Pull the cover off a bit	
You will now see a cut out in the bottom plate that looks like this.	
Inside this cut out sits the high temperature switch. It can be round (like the one shown) or rectangular. This is the high temperature switch. No matter which model high temperature switch	
you have there will be two (2) wires and one (1) ground attached to it.	
More importantly is a button sticking out from the center	
Push on the small reset button with a pencil or pen, this will reset the high temperature switch.	
Close the small cover and put the three (3) screws back in	ACHTUNG! Netzstecker ver dimen des Gerätnedeckeis Zirelven.
Put the big cover back on and put the four (4) screws back in
